



# HI THERE BOO TAG KIT INSTRUCTIONS

*Step 1* Dip the wet wipe in the white paint and wipe on your base for both tags. Cover well and set them aside to dry.

*Step 2* Take out the white sponge, dip it in the black paint and paint the words 'hi there BOO'. You can also paint the washers that go around the holes on the tags.

*Step 3* Now grab your stencil with the ghosts, flip it over so that it is face down and carefully (and slowly) peel off the back. Think of it as a big sticker and you are taking the back of the sticker off. Be very careful and make sure that all of the gray stencil material stays down. Once the sticky part of the stencil is exposed, flip it over and place it on your tag. Once it is in place press it down really well. You can use a debit card (or something similar) to "squeegee" it down.. Then slowly peel off the white layer, making sure the gray stencil material stays in place. Now you are ready to paint!

*Step 4* Next, you will paint over the ghosts with the black paint and the foam brush so that the entire tag is covered in black paint. Once it is dry, take the toothpick and remove the ghost stencils. You can use the baby wipe with some of the leftover white paint to distress the tag a bit if you wish.

*Step 5* Once everything is dry, place all of your pieces on the tags where you want them. Then glue the words, washers and overlap the BOO tag on top of the other one a bit.

*Step 6* Now we make the bow. You can either cut the ends of your ribbon or keep them straight, then pinch the ribbon in the middle, criss-cross the pieces one at a time, and then wrap the middle with the small piece of twine. Then you can either tie or glue it onto the tags.

*Step 7* Lastly, add your twine to hang it with & step back to admire your adorable new tags! Make sure to take a picture of your finished project and share it with us.
