



KIDS CAMP TIE DYE SIGN KIT INSTRUCTIONS

Step 1

Use your foam brush and begin with painting the base of your sign in the color(s) of your choice and then set it aside to dry. In our sample, our base is painted white.

Step 2

While the base of your sign dries, take out your 3D letters for your name, your white sponges, and the paint color of your choice. (We used black for this step.) Dab the excess paint from your sponge, use light coats of paint, and dab up and down (don't smear) on your letters. Be mindful not to get paint on the edges of the cutouts. Since these are laser-cut pieces the edges do not always cover well. Once they are painted, set them aside to dry.

Step 3

Now grab your tie dye stencil, flip it over face down and carefully (and slowly) peel off the back. Think of it as a big sticker and you are taking the back of the sticker off. Be very careful and make sure that all of the gray stencil material stays down. Once the sticky part of the stencil is exposed, flip it over and place it on your board. Once it is in place press it down really well. You can use a debit card (or something similar) to "squeegee" it down.. Then slowly peel off the white layer, making sure the gray stencil material stays in place. Now you are ready to paint!

Step 4

Take out your paint and white sponges, dip your sponge into the paint, wipe off the excess paint, and then dab up and down (don't smear) on the stencil. Don't use too much paint as it works best with 2 thin coats! Less is more! This is where you can get creative on your colors and filling in your tie dye pattern. Once it is completely covered with a 2-3 thin coats, you can peel off the stencil. It does not have to be completely dry for this step. Use a toothpick to remove any stencil pieces that are left behind.

Step 5

Once everything is dry, use the glue provided to glue your name to the board. This is SuperGlue so be very very careful.

Step 6
