



KIDS STENCIL KIT INSTRUCTIONS

Step 1

Use your foam brush and begin with painting the base of your sign in the color(s) of your choice and then set it aside to dry. In our sample, we used 3 different colors of teal.

Step 2

Once the base of your sign is dry, grab your stencil, flip it over face down and carefully (and slowly) peel off the back. Think of it as a big sticker and you are taking the back of the sticker off. Be very careful and make sure that all of the gray stencil material stays down. Once the sticky part of the stencil is exposed, flip it over and place it on your board. Once it is in place press it down really well. You can use a debit card (or something similar) to "squeegee" it down.. Then slowly peel off the white layer, making sure the gray stencil material stays in place.

Step 3

Now take out your sealer and a white sponge. Smooth out a THIN layer of sealer over the entire design. This helps to ensure that the design is nice and crisp. Let it dry.

Step 4

Take out your paint and white sponges, dip your sponge into the paint, wipe off the excess paint, and then dab up and down (don't smear) on the stencil. Don't use too much paint as it works best with thin coats! Your first coat will not look the best, but trust the process and remember less is more! This is where you can get creative on your colors and filling in your design. Once it is completely covered with a 2-3 thin coats, you can peel off the stencil. It does not have to be completely dry for this step. Use a toothpick to remove any stencil pieces that are left behind.

Step 5
